BEFORE READING

Talk together

- Read the title and ask your child if they have ever lost anything. Ask: Did you find it again?
- If you have been on a bus or a coach together, talk about what happened.
- Look through the book and talk about the pictures.

About the words in this book

 Ask your child to look out for words in the pictures as you enjoy the story together. Read these words for them:

Cover: The Lost Teddy

Page 6: Lost Property

DURING READING

Enjoy the story together and encourage your child to respond to the pictures.

- Ask your child to tell you what is happening in each picture.
- Talk about what might happen next, before you turn over each page.
- Discuss anything that the story reminds your child about.





















AFTER READING

- Talk about what happened in the story, encouraging your child to re-tell some of it.
- Ask: Why was Kipper unhappy at bedtime?
- Ask your child to guess what Kipper might have said to Biff and Chip when he came home after finding Teddy.
- Ask: What sounds does a bus make? Practise making some bus noises together or sing The Wheels on the Bus.
